- Your role is the facilitator. Leaders should speak about 30% of the time and the goal is for participants to share 70% of the time.
- Avoid controversial topics.

- Share your 3-Minute Testimony.
- Explain the flow of the group.
- Establish the best way to communicate with participants.
- Begin and end your group on time to establish trust.
